Set-up guide: WebDAV for Mac OS

Professional, Premium and Enterprise Feature

Access Kontainer folders and files directly from your computer via WebDAV. Once the WebDAV is mounted, you can easily navigate your Kontainer folders and search files by file name.

We recommend using [Mountain Duck](#) to mount WebDAV connections on Mac and Windows. It is a reliable, easy-to-use tool that allows you to connect Kontainer with your local drive.

Alternatively, you can [install a Kontainer WebDAV manually](#) to access your folders locally on your computer drive.

Follow the steps below to set up guides for the plugins below.

Set up with Mountain Duck

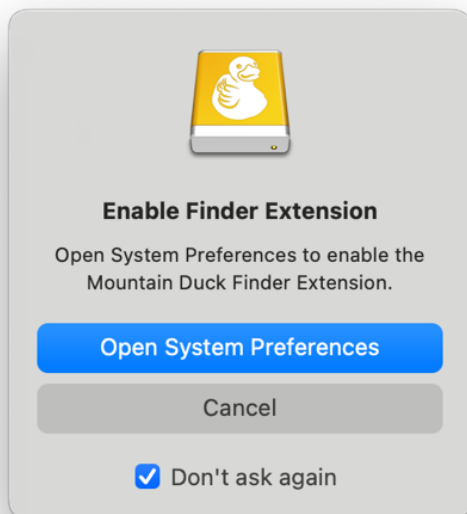


Go to mountainduck.io for a fast and stable WebDAV setup.

Step 1

Download and enable plugin

Find the app in downloads once the download is complete and double-click to enable the finder extension.



Step 2

Add Kontainer details and login

To set up the connection, you'll need to fill out the following details:

- In the field **Server**, enter your **Kontainer URL**, e.g., `styling.kontainer.com`

- Under **Username** and **Password**, fill in your own Kontainer login details
- Fill out the field **Path** with the word: **webdav**

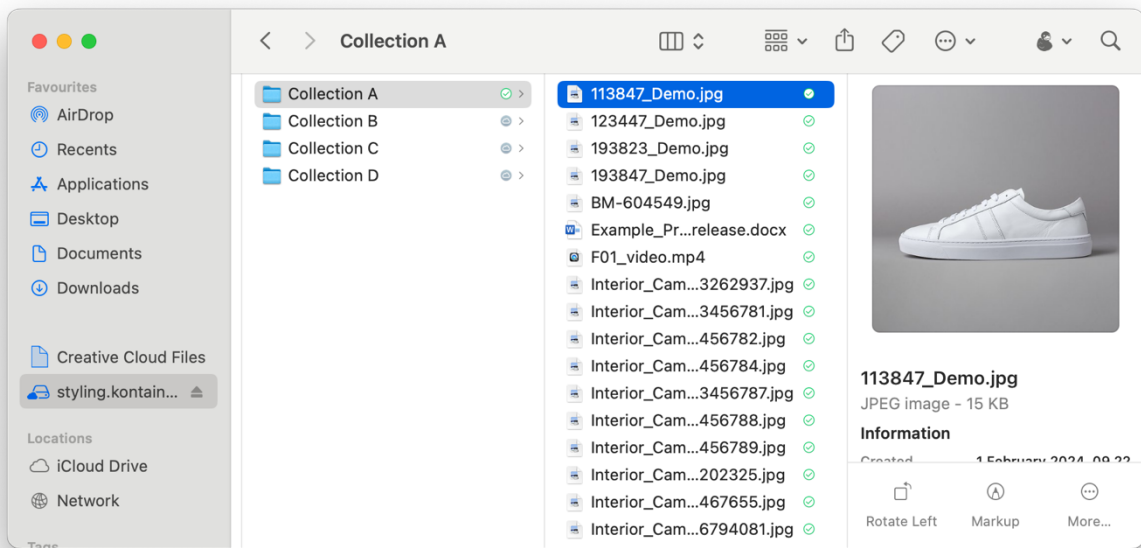

You'll now find your Kontainer added as a local web drive. This will grant you the same folder and file access you usually enjoy on the online platform.

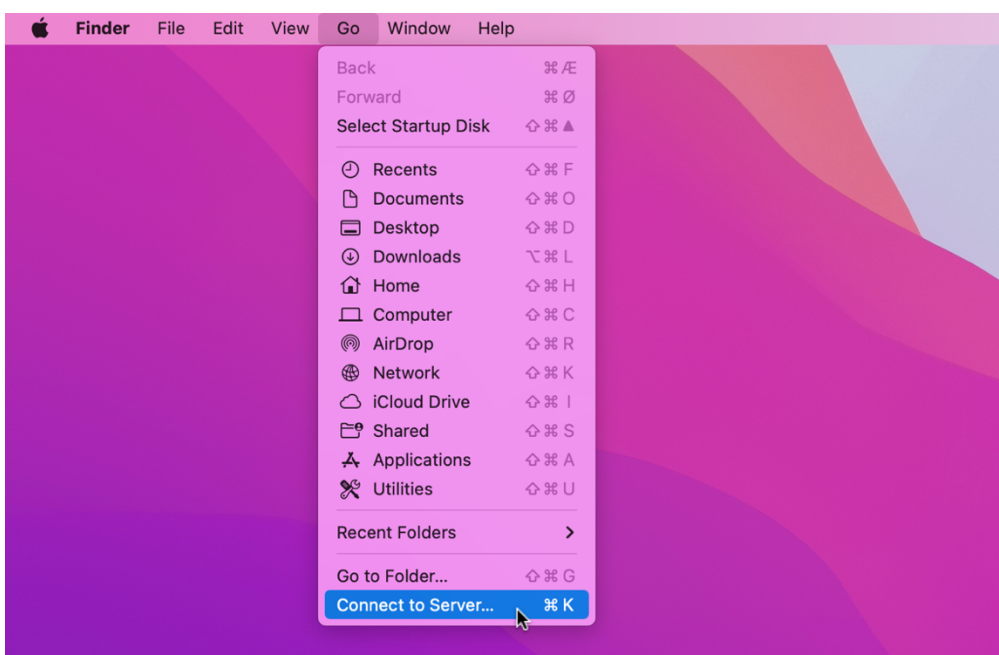


Set up WebDAV manually on Mac OS

Step 1

Connect to Server

Click on your desktop or open Finder. Then open the Go drop-down from your top menu bar. Select the option **Connect to Server**.



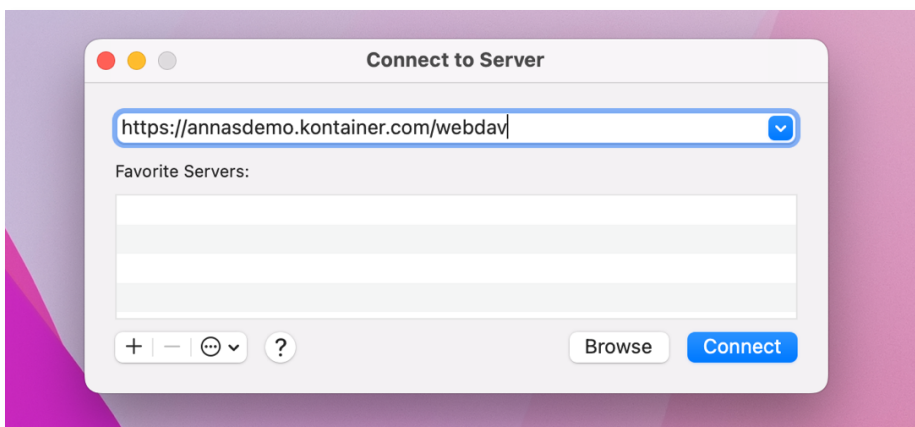
Step 2

Add Your Kontainer URL

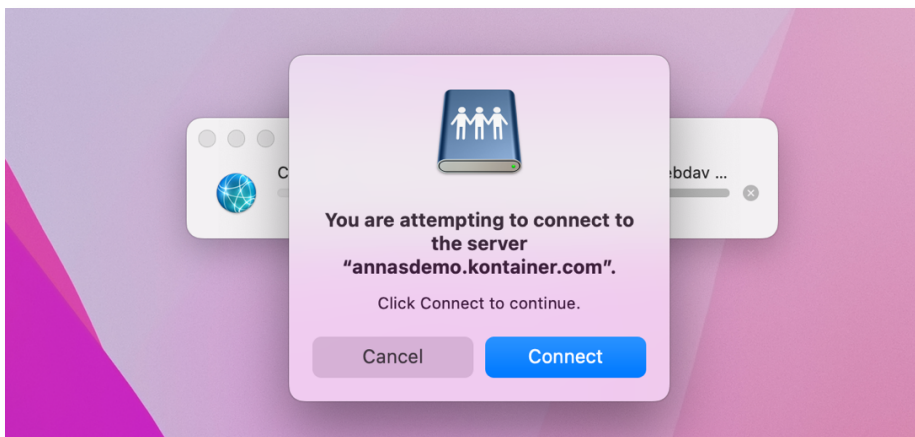
Add your Kontainer URL in the **Folder** path, adding **/webdav** at the end.

Example: <https://annasdemo.kontainer.com/webdav>

And click **Connect**.



Click on **Connect** again.

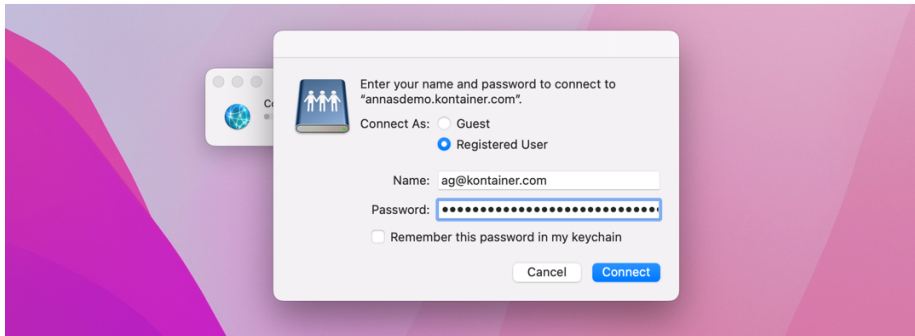


Step 3

Connect to Kontainer

Enter the username and password of the Kontainer access you want the WebDAV to use.

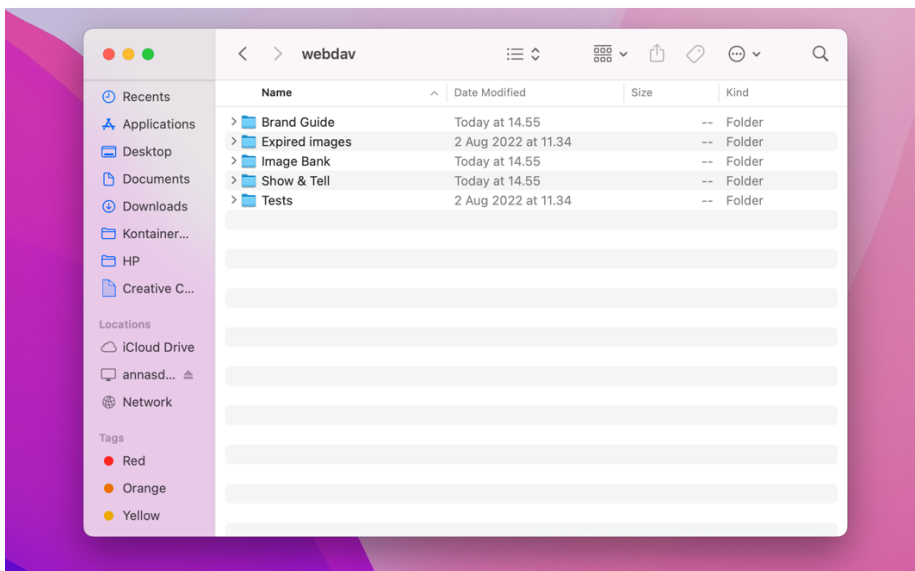
Click **Connect**.



Step 4

Access Your Files

You can now access all your assets from your folder structure in Kontainer. You can also search files by file name.
